Haverford Seeks Public Input on Future Development and Conservation

What should be done to revitalize older commercial areas? What types of housing should be encouraged in various areas? What should be done to protect existing neighborhoods? What road improvements are needed? How can we encourage public transit usage? What parks and trails improvements are needed? How can we make Haverford more pedestrian and bicycle friendly? How can we improve environmental sustainability? What should be done to preserve historic buildings?

Those are some of the questions that will be asked at two meetings on the Haverford Township Comprehensive Plan. An in-person meeting will be held on Wednesday September 22, 2021 in the Community Recreation and Environmental Center (CREC) building at 9000 Parkview Drive, which is southwest of Darby Road. The meeting will begin at 7 pm, with a 6:30 pm open house to allow persons to informally review maps. Masks are required.

The second meeting will be online using Zoom, on Tuesday September 28, 2021 at 7 pm. The Comprehensive Plan is an overall set of policies for the development and conservation of various areas of Haverford Township over the next 10 years. The plan addresses land uses, housing, transportation, community facilities, natural features, and ways to carry out the plan. The Comprehensive Plan will include recommendations for updates to certain zoning regulations, in addition to other policies.
